INVITATION TO SUBMIT FORMAL WRITTEN QUOTATIONS

TWO (2) WEEK PILOT PROGRAMME FOR ONSITE LABOUR BASED COLD ASPHALT MANUFACTURING THAT COMPLIES WITH RECOGNIZED ROAD STANDARDS AND SKILLS DEVELOPMENT TRAINING (ON-SITE TRAINING FOR 20 ROADS DEPARTMENT EMPLOYEES)

Ndlambe Local Municipality requires the implementation of a two (2) week pilot programme that includes manufacturing a **LABOUR BASED COLD ASPHALT** on site and skills development that is **CETA** aligned to be used as a tool to address the current state of its secondary/municipal roads network.

Service providers are requested to provide a detailed pilot programme with methodology and implementation on **COLD ASPHALT BATCH MIXING** facilities and **CETA** aligned training modules that cover the various tasks associated with these activities. All practical work must utilise a **LABOUR BASED SURFACING ASPHALT** that complies with **RECOGNIZED ROAD STANDARDS**

BIDDERS MUST PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING PRE-REQUISITE DOCUMENTS

- Proof of qualifications in Civil Engineering field at least a minimum of NQF level 6.
- Proof of CETA and accreditation to provide training on the following modules: Pre-batch & Mix Materials for Manufacturing, Maintain & Repair Bituminous Surfaces, Mix & Apply Slurry & Use & Maintain small plant on site.
- CV's of registered professionals and skilled development practitioners who will project manage and deliver all training.
- A feasibility study covering the asphalt technology to be used or asphalt test results must be provided.
- Provide portfolio of evidence where similar projects have been undertaken including projects description and contact details.
- Provide a copy of all training manuals that will be used for the course.

NDLAMBE MUNICIPALITY WILL

- Provide PPE for trainees.
- NLM will provide a list of Municipal / EPWP beneficiaries for the program.
- Provide storeroom for equipment and a parking area for mobile plant.
- Provide concrete slab of 50m² for mixing.

Bidders shall take note of the following BID CONDITIONS:

1. The bid price should be in R (ZAR) value.
2. Prices must be valid for at least 90 days from the closing date.
3. Prices quoted must be firm and must be inclusive of VAT.
4. Bids not complying with all specifications as set out above will be declared non-responsive and therefore not be considered for the preferential points calculation which will be used to determine the successful bidder.
5. Ndlambe Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or any other bid and reserves the right to accept the whole or part of a bid.
6. The lowest or only quotation will not necessarily be accepted.
7. An original tax clearance certificate issued by SARS must accompany all quotations OR a tax reference number and PIN or TCC number must be provided.
8. Bidders must complete Council's Declaration of Interest form (**MBD4**).
9. Bidders must complete Certificate of Independent Bid Determination (**MBD9**).
10. Bidders who wish to claim for preferential points for Specific Goals in terms of the Preferential Procurement Policy of Council and the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022, must submit a completed form **MBD 6.1** (included in the returnable document) as well as a **certified copy** of the proof of B-BBEE status level of contribution as follows:
 - 10.1.1. In the case of an **Affidavit**, commissioned by a Commissioner of Oaths
 - 10.1.2. In the case of a **B-BBEE Certificate**, only a "true copy" stamp and signature.
11. It should be noted that the 80/20 points system will be applied, 80 being for price and 20 for the B-BBEE status level as defined in the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017.
12. The award will be made in terms of the Municipality's Supply Chain Management Policy.
13. A Municipal Billing Clearance Certificate (in respect of both the company and, if applicable, directors/owners) must accompany all bids.
14. Evidence of registration of company on the Central Supplier Database (CSD "MAAA number) must be provided.

Late submitted, unmarked, faxed, falsified or e-mailed offers will not be considered and will be disqualified.

Completed returnable documents and supporting documentation must be placed in sealed envelopes marked "NOTICE NR 93/2024 or RFQ NO:84/2324 – PILOT PROGRAMME FOR ONSITE LABOUR BASED COLD ASPHALT MANUFACTURING" and must be placed in the tender box at the Supply Chain Management Unit, 44 Campbell Street, Port Alfred, not later than 12h00 on **20 May 2024**. Bids will be opened at the same venue from 12h05 on the same day.

N.B. ENVELOPES NOT MARKED AS INDICATED ABOVE WILL NOT BE OPENED AND SUCH BIDS WILL, AS A RESULT, BE DISQUALIFIED.
